An organically formed and centrally positioned stairwell connects the three levels of this media center. The open staircase not only serves as a dynamic movement and communication zone but also transmits light from the ceiling glazing into the space. Large apertures in the façade resemble shop-windows, presenting varied and exciting views of the surrounding town. The external, brighter, glazed areas house the reading zones and provide furniture that can transform from bench to table, which encourages users to stay and linger. This sculptural media center, creates a rich spatial experience- and communication hub for any age.
